- Location: Nongrah Construction started: December 2020.
- Total Project Cost: 1.50 Crores. Amount raised till March 2022: Rs 7100000
- IMMEDIATE AMOUNT REQUIRED FOR COMPLETION OF PHASE I: Rs 40 lakhs
- The Ministry was gifted with a plot of land at Nongrah on which the Lawei Baphyrnai Children's Home for Boys is being constructed. This facility will provide a proper permanent shelter with all the facililes that our growing children need. 


